
# Museum International

## ICOM Code of Ethics for Museums




The *ICOM Code of Ethics for Museums* was adopted in 1986 and revised in 2004. It establishes the values and principles shared by ICOM and the international museum community. As the cornerstone of ICOM, it sets minimum standards of professional practice and performance for museums and their staff.

The Code has been translated in 38 languages by ICOM's Committees, and was redesigned in 2017, in keeping with ICOM's new visual identity.

## ICOM Code of Ethics for Natural History Museums



It defines ethical standards on issues specific to Natural History Museums, and relevant to Life and Earth sciences. This Code has been translated into several languages, and in 2019, a German version of the Code has been published in collaboration with the German National Committee. ## ICOM Publishing Manual



## Culture and Local Development: Maximising the Impact





A mix of analytical articles and real-life case studies will offer diverse perspectives on core aspects of museum work.


